Dr. Frank Evans acquired his Medical Doctorate and Honours Bsc. in Pharmacology/Physiology at the University of Western Ontario in 1981. In 1978, he joined the Canadian Armed Forces where he became a Flight Surgeon and a board certified specialist in Aerospace Medicine. In 1992, Dr. Evans did a fellowship in Addiction Medicine, at Loma Linda Medical University, California. He is on staff at the Chemical Dependency Detox/Treatment unit, at Humber River Regional Hospital and at Bellwood Health Services treatment facility, where he is director of Bellwood's Health Professional Treatment Program. Dr. Evans also serves as chair of the Ontario Medical Association's, section of Addiction Medicine, and secretary/executive board member for the Canadian Society of Addiction Medicine.
