

## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

### COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF ONTARIO ANNUAL METHADONE PRESCRIBERS CONFERENCE TORONTO, ON – November 6, 2009

CONFERENCE THEME: This event is aimed at physicians who currently hold an exemption to prescribe methadone for the treatment of opioid dependence and who are currently providing methadone maintenance treatment to patients.

#### Abstract Presentation Formats

Abstracts may be presented in any of the following two formats:

1. Workshop – 60 minute workshop including small group discussions and skill building
2. Oral Presentation – 20 minute presentation and 10 minutes of questions/discussion

#### Abstract Requirements

All abstracts must be submitted in either hard copy or electronic copy on or before June 1, 2009. The abstract should not exceed 350 words.

#### Guidelines

Abstracts are welcomed in the following categories:

- Ø Original Research: quantitative and qualitative studies. The abstract should include a brief statement of the objective, rationale, methodology, results and conclusions of the study.
- Ø Program descriptions: description of the planning, implementation and/or evaluation of a program. No data are required.
- Ø Literature Review: Summary and analysis of the current literature on a specific topic.

***Abstracts and abstract submission form must be submitted by June 1, 2009.***

The authors will be notified at least three months prior to the conference by e-mail. Accepted abstracts will be printed in the final program that will be distributed on-site at the conference. Abstracts should only be submitted if the author intends to attend the conference and present the abstract. Those presenting abstracts will be responsible for their own travel and meeting expenses.
